

**Tenure-track Faculty Positions**  
**Eugene Applebaum College of Pharmacy and Health Sciences**



The Department of Pharmacy Practice at Wayne State University invites applications for two full-time tenure-track positions and one full-time nontenure-track position:

**Assistant/Associate Professor (tenure-track) – Health Outcomes, Health Policy or Health Economics.** The successful candidate(s) will be responsible for the development of an externally funded program of scholarship related to health outcomes, economics, epidemiology or health policy. This position will provide support for interdisciplinary research within the Eugene Applebaum College of Pharmacy and Health Sciences. Didactic teaching in professional and graduate programs is expected. Applicants with experience and expertise in health outcomes, economics, epidemiology or policy research are encouraged to apply. The search committee will consider candidates whose educational background is from a wide range of professional and scientific disciplines.

**Assistant/Associate Professor (tenure-track) – Clinical or Translational Research**

The successful candidate(s) will be expected to develop an externally funded program of clinical or translational research related to the pharmacologic treatment or prevention of human disease. Candidates with expertise in a variety of specialty areas of pharmacy or medicine will be considered. Didactic teaching in the PharmD program and graduate programs is expected. The successful candidate will possess a doctoral degree (PharmD, PhD, MD) with clinical and scientific training and expertise.

**Assistant Professor (nontenure-track) – Internal/General Medicine**

The successful candidate will be expected to develop a clinical practice related to internal or general medicine at St. John Hospital in metropolitan Detroit. The practice site will serve as a base for a program of applied/clinical research and experiential training of PharmD students. Didactic teaching in the PharmD program is expected. The successful candidate will possess a doctoral degree (PharmD) with residency training or equivalent clinical experience. Research training and experience is highly desirable.

Applications will be accepted until the positions are filled.
