

TRANSFER EQUIVALENCY GUIDE FOR GLEN OAKS COMMUNITY COLLEGE

This guide is not a comprehensive list of all equivalent courses. It reflects the most current courses offered by Glen Oaks Community College that will fulfill the general education requirements. Older courses not listed on this chart may also fulfill the general education requirements. Please refer to Wayne State University's Transfer Credit website www.transfercredit.wayne.edu for a more comprehensive list of courses that may fulfill these general education requirements. Students who transfer to Wayne State University with an Associate in Arts (A.A.) or an Associate in Science (A.S.) degree or have a MACRAO-stamped transcript do not have to complete the general education requirements. All courses that fulfill the general education requirements must have a grade of C/2.0 or higher.

An Associate of Applied Science (A.A.S.), an Associate of Business (A.B), or an Associate of General Studies (A.G.S.) does not fulfill the general education requirements. If you have an Associate of Applied Science, an Associate of Business, or an Associate of General Studies, you will be required to complete all of the general education requirements unless you have a MACRAO-stamped transcript.

- (1) The physical therapy program only requires two chemistry courses with at least one lab and topics do not overlap. Options include CHM 1020 or 1220/1230, CHM 1030 or CHM 1240/1250 or CHM 2220/2230.
- (2) For the pharmacy program starting with the class that enters fall 2016, you must have at least six semester credit hours of anatomy and physiology with at least three semester credit hours of anatomy of physiology at the 3000-level or higher
- (3) CHEM 134/General chemistry II, is not equivalent to Wayne State's CHM 1240+1250. CHEM 134 will only fulfill the second chemistry prerequisite for the physical therapy program. It will not fulfill the CHEM 1240+1250 prerequisite for Clinical Laboratory Science or Pharmacy.
