

TRANSFER EQUIVALENCY GUIDE FOR GRAND RAPIDS COMMUNITY COLLEGE

This guide is not a comprehensive list of all equivalent courses. It reflects the most current courses offered by Grand Rapids Community College that will fulfill the general education requirements. Older courses not listed on this chart may also fulfill the general education requirements. Please refer to Wayne State University's Transfer Credit website www.transfercredit.wayne.edu for a more comprehensive list of courses that may fulfill these general education requirements. Students who transfer to Wayne State University with an Associate of Arts (A.A.) or an Associate of Science (A.S.) degree or have a MACRAO-stamped transcript do not have to complete the general education requirements. All courses that fulfill the general education requirements must have a grade of C/2.0 or higher.

An Associate of Applied Arts and Science (A.A.A.S.), an Associate of business (A.B.), an Associate of Fine Arts (A.F.A.), an Associate of General Studies (A.G.S.), an Associate of Music (A.M.), or an Associate of Nursing, (A.N.) does not fulfill the general education requirements. If you have an Associate in Applied Arts and Science, an Associate of Business, an Associate of Fine Arts, an Associate of General Studies, an Associate of Music, or an Associate of Nursing, you will be required to complete all of the general education requirements unless you have a MACRAO-stamped transcript.
