

TRANSFER EQUIVALENCY GUIDE FOR LAKE MICHIGAN COLLEGE

This guide is not a comprehensive list of all equivalent courses. It reflects the most current courses offered by Lake Michigan College that will fulfill the general education requirements. Older courses not listed on this chart may also fulfill the general education requirements. Please refer to Wayne State University's Transfer Credit website www.transfercredit.wayne.edu for a more comprehensive list of courses that may fulfill these general education requirements. Students who transfer to Wayne State University with an Associate in Arts (A.A.) or an Associate in Science (A.S.) degree or have a MACRAO-stamped transcript do not have to complete the general education requirements. All courses that fulfill the general education requirements must have a grade of C/2.0 or higher.

An Associate in Applied Business (A.A.B), Associate in Applied Science (A.A.S.), an Associate in Business Administration (A.B.A.), an Associate in General Studies (A.G.S.), an Associate in Industrial Technology (A.I.T.), or an Associate in Skilled Trade Technology (A.S.T.) does not fulfill the general education requirements. If you have an Associate in Applied Business, an Associate in Applied Science, an Associate in Business Administration, an Associate in General Studies, an Associate in Industrial Technology, or an Associate in Skilled Trade Technology degree, you will be required to complete all of the general education requirements unless you have a MACRAO-stamped transcript.
