

TRANSFER EQUIVALENCY GUIDE FOR KALAMAZOO VALLEY COMMUNITY COLLEGE

This guide is not a comprehensive list of all equivalent courses. It reflects the most current courses offered by Kalamazoo Valley Community College that will fulfill the general education requirements. Older courses not listed on this chart may also fulfill the general education requirements. Please refer to Wayne State University's Transfer Credit website www.transfercredit.wayne.edu for a more comprehensive list of courses that may fulfill these general education requirements. Students who transfer to Wayne State University with an Associate of Arts (A.A.) or an Associate of Science (A.S.) degree or have a MACRAO-stamped transcript do not have to complete the general education requirements. All courses that fulfill the general education requirements must have a grade of C/2.0 or higher.

An Associate of Applied Science (A.A.S.) does not fulfill the general education requirements. If you have an Associate of Applied Science, you will be required to complete all of the general education requirements unless you have a MACRAO-stamped transcript.

- (2) For the pharmacy program starting with the class that enters fall 2016, you must have at least six semester credit hours of anatomy and physiology with at least three semester credit hours of anatomy of physiology at the 3000-level or higher.
