

## TRANSFER EQUIVALENCY GUIDE FOR KIRTLAND COMMUNITY COLLEGE

This guide is not a comprehensive list of all equivalent courses. It reflects the most current courses offered by Kirtland Community College that will fulfill the general education requirements. Older courses not listed on this chart may also fulfill the general education requirements. Please refer to Wayne State University's Transfer Credit website [www.transfercredit.wayne.edu](http://www.transfercredit.wayne.edu) for a more comprehensive list of courses that may fulfill these general education requirements. Students who transfer to Wayne State University with an Associate in Arts (A.A.) or an Associate in Science (A.S.) degree or have a MACRAO-stamped transcript do not have to complete the general education requirements. All courses that fulfill the general education requirements must have a grade of C/2.0 or higher.

An Associate in Business Administration (A.B.A.), an Associate in Computers (A.C.), or an Associate in Fine Arts (A.F.A) does not fulfill the general education requirements. If you have an Associate in Business Administration, an Associate in Computers, or an Associate in Fine Arts, you will be required to complete all of the general education requirements unless you have a MACRAO-stamped transcript.

- (1) The physical therapy program only requires two chemistry courses with at least one lab and topics do not overlap. Options include CHM 1020 or 1220/1230, CHM 1030 or CHM 1240/1250 or CHM 2220/2230.
- (2) For the pharmacy program starting with the class that enters fall 2016, you must have at least six semester credit hours of anatomy and physiology with at least three semester credit hours of anatomy of physiology at the 3000-level or higher
- (3) CHE 10201/General chemistry II lecture and CHE 10202/General chemistry II laboratory is not equivalent to Wayne State's CHM 1240+1250. CHE 10201+10202 will only fulfill the second chemistry prerequisite for the physical therapy program. It will not fulfill the CHM 1240+1250 prerequisite for Clinical Laboratory Science or Pharmacy.
